We see no reason to interfere with the impugned order. The special leave petition is dismissed. The petitioner is, however, granted time till 28.02.2014 to vacate the premises on the following conditions:

1) The petitioner files an undertaking on usual terms within four weeks.

2) The petitioner continues to pay to the respondents compensation for use and occupation of the premises @ Rs. 50,000/- p.m. fixed by the High Court till

the date of actual vacation. In case of any default in payment of rent the decree of eviction shall become executable forthwith.
