It is an admitted fact that appellant has been in jail as an undertrial prisoner from 14.2.2000 till now. The offences alleged against him are mainly under Section 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act besides Section 467, 468 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code. In view of the fact that he has been in jail for a long period now and the fact that there is no necessity for keeping him as an undertrial prisoner any more, we order him to be released on bail on his executing a bond in a sum of Rs.50,000/- with two solvent sureties to the satisfaction
