Heard Mr. S.B Sanyal, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner.

We find no merit in this petition for special leave. It is dismissed.

It is, however, urged before us that the petitioner is suffering from certain ailments, including Papillary Carcinoma Thyroid. A number of certificates and prescriptions have been filed along with the special leave petition as additional documents. We do not wish to express any opinion on the nature of the petitioner's ailment.

We, however, leave it open to the petitioner to move the appropriate Government in terms of Section 433(d) of the Code of Criminal Procedure requesting for commutation in sentence.
