We further direct that Additional Sessions Judge, Court No. 1, Allahabad who tried Sessions Case No. 152 of 1999 against the respondent shall hold an inquiry in terms of Section 7 (A) of The Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2000 to determine whether or not the respondent was a juvenile within the meaning of the said Act as on the date of the commission of the offence.

Needless to say that the trial court shall issue notice to the respondent and that the petitioner shall be free to appear before the trial court to assist the court in the proposed inquiry. The report of the inquiry shall be submitted to this court within eight weeks from the date the respondent appears before the trial court.
