O R D E R

1. Application for exemption from filing official translation is allowed.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the pecuniary advantage have been received. The family of the decesased has received (two years salary) from the employer.
3. However, when it comes to motor accident, death is caused and the amount is received from whatever source it may be adjusted.
4. In support of the said contention reliance has been placed on

judgment of Reliance General Insurance Company Limited Versus Shashi Sharma 2016 (9) SCC 627.

5. Issue notice, returnable in six weeks.

6. In the meantime, subject to deposit of Rs. 2 Crores with the Registry of this Court within four weeks, the execution of the interim award shall remain stayed.
