UPON hearing the counsels, the Court made the following

O R D E R

1. The submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that a plain reading of the First Information Report ("FIR") would reveal that there has been consensual relationship between the complainant and the

accused; and the allegation in respect of use of caste related words is vague with no details as also whether such words were used in public view.

2. Issue notice, returnable in six weeks.

3. In the meantime, it is provided that in the event the Petitioner is arrested in connection with Case No. 95/2024, P.S. Manpur, District Nalanda, he shall be released on a personal bond of Rs. 25,000/- subject to an undertaking that he shall cooperate in the investigation and make himself available for interrogation as and when required by the investigating agency. He shall also submit an undertaking that he will not threaten the witnesses or tamper the evidence.
