Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, we request the trial Court to dispose of the suits (Special Civil Suit No.339/2009 pending before Civil Judge, Senior Division, Kolhapur and Special Suit No.220/2009 pending before Civil Judge, Senior Division, Solapur) expeditiously preferably within four months and direct the parties to cooperate with the trial court for early disposal of the suit.

It is needless to say that any observation made by the High Court in the impugned orders being with reference to rejection of the appeal with reference to the temporary injunction, the trial Court will decide the

suit on the basis of the material placed before it in  
accordance with law, without being influenced by any  
observation by the High Court.
