UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The High Court has denied regular bail to the petitioner in connection with Case Crime No. 531 of 2023 registered with Kotwali Nagar Police Station, District Banda, State of U.P. for the offence punishable under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, "IPC") respectively.

2. At the end of the investigation, charge-sheet came to be filed and the filing of the-charge sheet culminated in Criminal Case No. 7658 of 2023 pending in the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banda, U.P.

3. The charge came to be framed by the Trial Court on 5th September, 2023 and till this date, two witnesses have been examined.

4. It is very unfortunate that this matter had to travel upto the highest Court of this country.

5. We fail to understand why bail was declined by the High Court in the first instance.

6. We take notice of the fact that the petitioner is in judicial custody as an under-trial prisoner since 30th June, 2023 in a Magistrate triable offence.

7. We order that the petitioner be released on bail forthwith, if not required in any other case, subject to terms and conditions that the trial court may deem fit to impose.

8. The trial shall proceed further expeditiously."

9. With the aforesaid, this petitioner stands disposed of.

10. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
