In the light of the submission advanced by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is ready and willing to pay a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lacs and Fifty Thousand) to each of the workmen in lieu of their reinstatement and back wages as directed by the High Court in the impugned order dated 20.4.2012, nothing survives in it. Learned counsel further submitted that in fact the amount was tendered to the respondents, but they have not accepted the same.

If the petitioner is ready and willing to comply with the direction, as contained in the impugned order passed by the Division Bench on 20th April, 2012, nothing survives in the special leave petitions, which are accordingly dismissed as such. However, the question of law is left open to be projected in an appropriate case.
