UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The petitioner challenges the judgment and order dated 13.02.2026 in CRMM No. 53968/2024 titled "Joginder Kaur Sandhu vs. State of Punjab & Anr." passed by the High Court of Punjab & Haryana at Chandigarh.
2. Issue notice, returnable on 18.05.2026.
3. Ms. Nupur Kumar, learned AOR accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. Hence, service of formal notice on respondent No.1 is waived.

4. Let notice be issued to respondent no.2 through the office of the concerned Senior Superintendent of Police. Let steps for service be taken within one week.

5. In the notice itself, let it be mentioned that respondent is required to file a counter affidavit and reply to the interlocutory application(s), if any, before the next date of listing.

6. In the event of arrest in connection with F.I.R. No.100/2024 dated 08.08.2024, registered at P.S.Dugri, District-Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, the petitioner shall be released on bail by the Investigating/Arresting Officer on such terms and conditions as imposed and found to be just, fair and reasonable. In addition to other conditions which may be imposed by the Investigation Officer, the petitioner shall immediately deposit her passport with the concerned Trial Court.

7. The petitioner shall make himself available before the Investigating Officer on 27.04.2026 at 10:00 a.m. and on all such dates as he may be required.

8. Needless to add, the petitioner would maintain good conduct and not attempt to influence any of the witnesses, in any manner, till the completion of the trial.
