O R D E R

2. We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

- 6. Learned counsel for the petitioner to serve a copy of the present petition to learned counsel for the respondents within a period of one (01) week.**
- 7. Let counter affidavit be filed within three (03) weeks. Rejoinder affidavit thereto, if any, be filed before the next date of listing.**
- 8. In the event of arrest in connection with Crime No.128 of 2025 of City Police Station, Gurugram District, Gurugram, the petitioner shall be released on bail on the appropriate terms and conditions as may be fixed by the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.**
- 9. The petitioner shall make himself available before the Investigating Officer on 20.04.2026 at 10:00 a.m. and on all such dates as he may be required.**

if the challan/charge sheet is filed, he would maintain good conduct and not attempt to influence any of the witnesses in any manner till the completion of the trial.
