O R D E R

5. In such counter affidavit to be filed by the respondent-State, atleast 48 hours before the returnable date, it may be indicated as to whether the petitioner was called upon to join investigation and, if so, what has been his response.

6. Rejoinder thereto, if any, may be filed by a week thereafter.
