The delay 54 days in filing the special leave petition is condoned.

This petition is directed against the order of the Division Bench of the Karnataka High Court which declined to interfere with the order passed by the Karnataka Administrative Tribunal (for short, "the Tribunal") for reinstatement of the respondent with 50% back wages.

We have heard Shri V.N. Raghupathy, learned counsel for the petitioners and carefully perused the

In our considered view, the reasons assigned by the Tribunal for nullifying the termination of the respondent's service and for directing her reinstatement with 50% back wages were legally correct and the High Court rightly refuse to interfere with the same.

The special leave petition is accordingly dismissed.

The petitioners shall, if they have already not done so, implement the order of the Tribunal within a period of two months from today.
