UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

This petition is directed against order dated 02.04.2012 passed by the learned Single Judge of the Punjab and Haryana High Court, whereby he dismissed the second appeal filed by the petitioner by observing that the same does not give rise to any question of law much less substantial question of law.

After arguing the case for some time, Shri V. Giri, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner made a request that his client may be permitted to withdraw the special leave petition with liberty to seek review of the order under challenge.

The request of the learned senior counsel is accepted and the special leave petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty in terms of the prayer made.

However, it is made clear that the liberty granted to the petitioner to file review petition shall not be construed as a mandate of this Court to the High Court to entertain and accept the review petition and if any such petition is filed, the High Court shall consider the same on its own merits.

The respondents shall also be free to bring it to the notice of the High Court the various judgments in which a finding has been recorded that the petitioner is not the daughter of Srimati Sumitra Choudhary and the fact that those judgments have attained finality.

Interim order dated 21.08.2012 stands automatically vacated.
