Having heard learned counsel for the
petitioners and carefully perused the record, we are
convinced that the order of injunction passed by the
trial Court did not suffer from any legal infirmity and
the learned Single Judge of the High Court rightly
declined to interfere with the same. The approach
adopted by the learned Single Judge is consistent with

the law laid down by this Court in N.R. Dogre versus
Whirlpool Corporation (1996) 5 SCC 714 and Skyline
Education Institute (India) Pvt. Ltd. versus S.L.
Vaswani and another (2010) 2 SCC 142.
