O R D E R

This is a petition for transfer of Petition No.2/09 filed
by the respondent under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act,
1955 which is pending before the Family Court No.1 Jaipur
(Rajasthan).

The petitioner, who is a resident of Vizianagaram (Andhra
Pradesh) has sought transfer of the case filed by the
respondent mainly on the ground that it will be extremely
difficult for her to leave her minor child and travel to
Jaipur (Rajasthan).

We have heard learned counsel for the parties and
perused the record. In our view, it will be in the interest
of justice to accept the prayer made by the petitioner.

Accordingly, the transfer petition is allowed and
petition No. 2/09 titled Umesh Kumar Bhair vs. Smt. Sangeetha
Bhair is transferred from Family Court No.1 Jaipur within
the State of Rajasthan to Family Court, Vizinagaram within the
State of Andhra Pradesh.
