This petition is directed against judgment
dated 3.6.2010 passed by the Division Bench of Kerala
High Court whereby the appeal preferred by the
petitioner against order dated 9.4.2010 passed by

Family Court, Thrissur was dismissed.

We have heard learned senior counsel for the
petitioner and carefully perused the record.

After making some submissions and realising
that the Court is not inclined to interfere with the
impugned judgment, Shri V. Giri, learned senior counsel
appearing for the petitioner made a request that his
client may be permitted to withdraw this petition so

that she may approach the Mediation Centre attached to Kerala High Court for making an effort to resolve the dispute with her husband amicably.

In the peculiar facts of the case, we accept the request of the learned senior counsel and dispose of the special leave petition as withdrawn with liberty in terms of the prayer made.
