This application is directed against an order of
eviction, which order stood affirmed by dismissal of the
State's appeal before the appellate court being barred by
time, and against the said order a revision was filed, that
also was dismissed by the High Court. We see hardly any
justification for interference by this Court under Article
136 of the Constitution. The SLP is accordingly dismissed.
The counsel appearing for the State prayed that some time be
given to deliver vacant possession of the premises. Having
considered his submissions, and the fact that the Office of
the State Government is there in the premises in question, we
direct that the State shall deliver vacant possession of the
premises on or before 31st March, 2002 and would pay the
necessary monthly rent/damages during that period, and
subject to further undertaking being given within four weeks
from today.
