Having heard Mr. M.N. Rao, learned counsel for the
applicants, Mr. P.P.Rao, learned senior counsel for the
Devasthanams and the learned counsel appearing for the State
of Andhra Pradesh, notwithstanding the circular dated

4.11.1996 which was placed before us on behalf of the
Devasthanam, and particularly clause (iv) thereof, we clarify

that the employees concerned will get the minimum salary in the minimum scale of pay and the dearness allowance permissible thereon as per clause (i) of the said circular. Devasthanams would do well in making these payments within a period of three months from today, after adjusting the payments already made.

The amount which has been lying in deposit of this Court pursuant to interim order may be refunded to Devasthanams.
