This is a petition for transfer of matrimonial proceedings by the wife who states

that she is an Air Hostess on day duties and has a small child of one and half year old. The

husband - respondent is in Army and has now been transferred from Mhow (M.P.) to

Bangalore. The matrimonial proceedings have been instituted by the husband in Pune.

As

the husband has also been transferred to Bangalore, in our opinion, this is a fit case for

transfer of the matrimonial proceedings pending at Pune to a competent Court at Delhi

The Transfer Petition is allowed.

The Marriage Petition No.239 of 2004 filed before the Family Court, Pune,

titled as Captain KIrpal Singh Gill Vs. Mrs. Preeti Gill, shall stand transferred to Delhi.

The District Judge shall try the case himself or assign it to a competent Court.

Learned counsel appearing for the wife assures that since respondent -

husband has to come from a long distance, as and when there are dates, no adjournment will

be sought by the petitioner - wife on unreasonable grounds.
