UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
ORDER

A limited notice was issued confined to the question as to how
much more time would be required to complete the investigation, if not
already done.

In the counter affidavit filed on behalf of respondent No. 2, it is
stated that the investigation was completed long back as would appear
from the letter dated 23.07.2008. However, it is stated at the Bar that
in fact charge sheet has been filed on 02.07.2009. In that view of the
matter. no further order need be passed.

However, the learned counsel for respondent No. 2 submits that
petitioner No. 1 has not yet appeared. It is, however, stated by Mr.
Amit Sharma, the learned counsel for the petitioner that the

application for anticipatory bail is pending before this Court. We have no doubt in our mind that the trial judge shall proceed in accordance with law. We, however, request the trial judge to consider the desirability of disposing of this matter as expeditiously as possible after the order in any way or the other is passed by this Court in the pending special leave petition.

The special leave petition is dismissed with the above observations.
