UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

SLP(Crl.) No. 4199/10 filed by Nagar Singh &
Another, against the order of the Jammu & Kashmir High
Court, dated 3rd May, 2010, rejecting their bail
application in connection with FIR No. 247/09 of Police
Station Gandhi Nagar, Jammu, and SLP(Crl.) No. 6047/10
filed by Ms. Deepinder Kaur, against the order of the

aforesaid High Court dated 3rd May, 2010, granting bail
to Jaggar Singh, together with sLP(Crl.) No. 5803/10,
filed by the State of Jammu & Kashmir, against the same
order, are taken up together for consideration.

Since the matter is pending at the stage of
framing of charge, we are not inclined to make any
observations with regard to the submissions made on
behalf of the parties, but we are not inclined to
entertain the Special Leave Petition filed by Nagar
Singh & Another, for grant of bail. The same is,
accordingly, dismissed at this stage. As far as the
SLPs filed by Ms. Deepinder Kaur and the State of Jammu

& Kashmir are concerned, it appears that the order passed by the High Court granting bail to Jaggar Singh is in the facts has revealed in the impugned order of the High Court and does not require any intervention. The said Special Leave petitions, are, therefore, also dismissed.

We, however request the learned Sessions Judge to take immediate steps for framing of charge since some of the submissions which were made before us for grant of bail are directly linked with the framing of charge. It may also be noted that the petitioners in SLP(Crl.) No. 4199/10 are in custody are under trials since November, 2009, since the trial cannot start without charge being framed.
