UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
ORDER

It is unfortunate that for couple of months, process fees are not paid at least in 25% of the cases. This is the real cause of delay in completing the matters.

As a last chance petitioner has to file process fee and spare copies within two weeks.

If process fee and spare copies are filed within two weeks, issue notice as per earlier order and list before this Court on 12-5-2009.

If process fee and spare copies are not filed within two weeks, list the matters before the Hon'ble Judge-in-Chamber for non-prosecution against the unserved respondents. However, Registry shall not wait for process fee and spare copies till 12-5-2009 and the matters shall be listed before the Hon'ble Judge-in-Chamber at the earliest after two weeks, in case of non-payment of process fee and non-filing of spare copies within two weeks.

Dasti service is permitted to be served through the Tribunal or the nearest Civil Court, if so desired by the petitioner. Such Court is

directed to serve the notice even by affixing the same at the given address, if the process server could not serve it in due course and to file proper report as provided under the Code of Civil Procedure.
