In modification of the interim order made by the Division Bench of the High Court of Madras, we direct the appellant herein to pay wages at the rate of Rs.69/- per day w.e.f. 1st November, 2004 to those workers who are working in the categories 'a. to h.' mentioned at page 32 of the appeal paper book till the disposal of the writ appeal pending before the Division Bench of the Madras High Court. We request the said Division Bench of the Madras High Court to dispose of the appeal at an early date before 31st January, 2005. The fixation of Rs.69/- is an ad hoc fixation and will not be taken as precedent for deciding the issue. With the above modification the appeal is disposed of.
