Heard learned counsel for the parties.

We are satisfied that the petitioner has made out a case for transfer of the case from Tis Hazari Civil Court, Delhi to the Family Court, Mumbai.

We, accordingly, direct that H.M.A. No.Nil of 2003, titled Aniljit Singh Vs. Tina Singh @ Urmit Aniljit Singh, pending before the Additional District and Sessions Judge, Tis Hazari, Delhi shall stand transferred to the Family Court at Mumbai.

The respondent's counsel contends that the respondent apprehends danger to his life if the case is transferred to Mumbai. We do not express any opinion on the submission of the learned counsel. In case the respondent has any threat apprehension, he is at liberty to move to appropriate Court for his security.

The transfer petition is accordingly allowed.
