This transfer petition has been filed seeking the transfer of a case arising out of criminal complaint bearing STC No.1877 of 2007 filed before the Court of XIV Small Causes Judge, Chennai, Tamil Nadu dated 13.9.2005 under the provisions of Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act of 1881.

Large number of grounds had been taken in the transfer petition and it has been submitted by the learned counsel before us that the court where the complaint had been filed lacks jurisdiction as no part of the transaction has taken place within the territorial jurisdiction of the said court.

We do not see any reason to entertain the transfer petition. The petitioner is at liberty to raise all factual and legal issues before the court concerned and
