UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. We heard Mr. Mukul Rohatgi, Mr. Rohan Shah and Mr. Anshin H Desai, the learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners.
2. This petition arises from the order passed by a Division Bench of the High Court dated 09.04.2026 in Letters Petition

Appeal No.293/2026 by which the Division Bench dismissed the Letters Petition Appeal preferred by the petitioners before us, thereby declining to grant ad-interim relief which was prayed for before the learned Single Judge in the first instance.

3. We take notice of the fact that the petitioners before us have preferred a Writ Petition in the form of Special Civil Application No.3835/2026 seeking appropriate reliefs.

4. This Writ Petition was taken up for hearing by a learned Single Judge on 20.03.2026 and notice was issued, making it returnable on 20.04.2026.

5. It appears that some ad-interim relief was also prayed for by the petitioners, however, it does not seem to have been granted by the learned Single Judge order so far.

6. In the meantime, the petitioners went before the Division Bench by way of Letters Patent Appeal and prayed for ad-interim relief. The Division Bench declined to grant any relief.

7. In such circumstances referred to above, the petitioners are here before us.

8. Since the main matter, i.e., Special Civil Application No.3835/2026 is to come up for hearing on 20.04.2026, let the learned Single Judge hear the parties insofar as the ad-interim relief prayed for by the petitioners is concerned and pass an appropriate order.

9. Insofar as the matter before us is concerned, we propose to keep it after two weeks.

10. On the next date of hearing, the learned counsel shall inform us about the further developments in the matter.
