submits that pursuant to the directions of the High Court, a survey  
was conducted by a Committee and the department is awaiting the  
Report of the said Committee. He also submits that there are about  
1063 unauthorised schools out of which about 478 unauthorised  
schools have already applied for recognition and survey will continue  
for a period of another six months.
