O R D E R

This petition is directed against order dated 26.4.2010 passed by the learned Single Judge of Bombay High Court in Writ Petition No.2111 of 2010 whereby the amount of maintenance payable to respondent no.1 and the child has been fixed at Rs.1,00,000/- and Rs.50,000/- respectively.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

In our view, the impugned order does not suffer from any legal infirmity requiring interference under Article 136 of the Constitution.                      The special

However, sixty days' time is allowed to the petitioner to pay the balance amount payable in terms of the order passed by the High Court. We also give liberty to the parties to move the Family Court for expediting disposal of the matter pending before it.
