UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

This is an application seeking exemption from surrendering in a matter in which the petitioner has been convicted under Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of one year along with a fine of `1,000/-.

Learned counsel has sought exemption on the plea that the petitioner is aged 70 years and is suffering from severe heart ailment and is also highly diabetic. He has further stated that the amount of fine of `1,000/- has already been deposited by the petitioner when his application for bail was considered by the High Court.

Considering the medical condition of the petitioner as also the fact that the sentence is relatively of a shorter duration which is also under challenge, it is considered appropriate that his Special Leave Petition may be heard on merit without insisting for the proof of surrender.

Application seeking exemption thus be treated as allowed.
