UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
ORDER

We find no ground to interfere. The special leave petition is dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the condition that the petitioners should pay Rs.5,000/- per month to the first respondent apart from paying Rs.1,500/- per month to the Society is very onerous. If so, it is open to the petitioners to apply before the High Court for modification of the direction for paying additional amount of Rs.5,000/- per month to reduce it to a reasonable amount. We make it clear that such a request may be considered in accordance with law provided the petitioners vacate the premises within two weeks from today and make the application within four weeks from today.
