O R D E R

From the materials disclosed in these proceedings, we are not in a position to appreciate the reasons given for the 'Look Out Notice', to have been issued in respect of the petitioner.

Learned ASG, Mr. Harin Pravinkant Raval, submits that there are several things which cannot be disclosed by way of affidavits and the same may be disclosed to the Court separately.

Accordingly, let this matter stand over till 22nd August, 2012, and be listed before the 'part-heard' matter(s).

In the meantime, the respondent No.1/CBI is given liberty to provide such material it considers necessary to justify the Look Out Notice in a sealed cover, which should be with the Registry, at least by the 21st of August, 2012.

Liberty is given to the petitioner to amend the writ petition, in order to challenge the Look Out Notice, which has been disclosed in the counter affidavit filed on behalf of the C.B.I. A copy of the same may be served on the learned AOR for the C.B.I. by tomorrow, and the CBI will also be at liberty to deal with the same before the next date.
