This special leave petition has been filed against an interim order passed by the Division Bench of the High Court of Madras in Writ Appeal No. 22 of 2011. It is true that since the Division Bench of the High Court has refused to stay the direction of the learned Single Judge to regularise the services of the respondent, the petitioners will be obliged to regularise the respondent's services pending final decision in the Writ Appeal. There is no legal basis for the apprehension of the petitioners that their right to question the correctness of the direction to regularise the services of the respondent will be foreclosed if the services of the respondent are regularised pending final

decision in the Writ Appeal. The interim order and its compliance cannot affect the contention of the petitioners in the Writ Appeal.

With the above clarification, the special leave petition is dismissed.
