UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. We have heard learned State Counsel for the applicant-State of Andhra Pradesh and learned counsel for the appellants in all the above Miscellaneous Applications.

2. By order dated 15.04.2026, five Criminal Appeals bearing Criminal Appeal No(s). 2143/2014, Criminal

Appeal No(s). 2146/2014, Criminal Appeal No(s). 2144/2014, Criminal Appeal No(s). 2145/2014 and Criminal Appeal No(s). 2147/2014 were disposed of in the following terms:

"1. We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent-State on instruction submits that the appellants in these Criminal Appeals, have been granted remission and thereafter, released from the concerned jail.

3. That being the position, nothing survives in this batch of Criminal Appeals.

4. All the Criminal Appeals are, accordingly, disposed of.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of."

Learned State counsel submits that barring Criminal Appeal No(s). 2147/2014, the appellants in the other four Criminal Appeals have not yet been granted remission, though they are out on bail on orders passed by this Court. Various issues have been raised in those appeals including the question of juvenility of the appellants. For that reason, these four appeals would have to be heard on merits. Wrong submission was made due to a communication gap.

4. Learned counsel for the appellants do not dispute the above submission.

5. In view of the above, the order dated 15.04.2026 is recalled only in respect to Criminal Appeal No(s).

2143/2014, 2146/2014, 2144/2014 and 2145/2014.

6. Criminal Appeal No(s). 2147/2014 stands disposed of in terms of order dated 15.04.2026 passed by this Court.

7. Accordingly, the four Miscellaneous Application(s) are disposed of and Criminal Appeal No.2143/2014, Criminal Appeal No.2144/2014, Criminal Appeal No.2145/2014 and Criminal Appeal No.2146/2014 are restored to their original files.

7. In view of the abovementioned order, list Criminal Appeal No.2143/2014, Criminal Appeal No.2144/2014, Criminal Appeal No.2145/2014 and Criminal Appeal No.2146/2014 on 29.07.2026.
