UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.
2. The petitioners' application under Order XLI Rule 5 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 before the First Appellate Court came to be rejected whereupon the civil revision was filed before the High Court. The High Court has entertained the civil revision and directed notices to be issued fixing 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2026 as the date for consideration.

3. The submission of learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have not been granted any interim relief by the High Court and non-grant of interim relief would frustrate their civil revision itself.

4. Be that as it may, since the impugned order is interlocutory in nature and simply directs for issuing notice of motion fixing a date, we do not intend to interfere with the said order.

5. We, however, permit the petitioners to move a fresh application before the High Court in the revision for expeditious consideration of the revision by advancing the date already fixed or to hear their application for interim relief on account of the urgency in the matter. In case, any such effort is made on the part of the petitioners, we expect the High Court will do the needful.

6. The special leave petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
