O R D E R

1. The petitioner challenges the judgment and order dated 12.03.2026 in Criminal Miscellaneous No.66141/2025 passed by the High Court of Judicature at Patna.
2. We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Issue notice, returnable on 25.05.2026.
4. Mr. Manish Kumar, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State. Hence, the formal service of notice on the respondent is waived.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner to serve a copy of the present petition to learned counsel for the respondent forthwith.
6. Let counter affidavit be filed within three (03) weeks. Rejoinder affidavit thereto, if any, be filed before the next date of listing.
7. We make it clear that no further opportunity will be granted for this purpose.
8. In the event of arrest in connection with Crime No.5790020250137 of 2025 of Kako Police Station, Jehanabad District, Bihar, the petitioner shall be released on bail on the appropriate terms and conditions as may be fixed by the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer. However, in the attending facts, one of the conditions shall necessarily be that if the petitioner possesses a passport, the same shall be deposited before the Competent Authority/Court, till the conclusion of the Trial or directed otherwise.
9. The petitioner shall make himself available before the Investigating Officer on 04.05.2026 at 10:00 a.m. and on all such dates as he may be required.
10. Needless to add, till the investigation is not complete in all respects, the petitioner would fully cooperate, and

if the challan/charge sheet is filed, he would maintain good conduct and not attempt to influence any of the witnesses in any manner till the completion of the trial.
