O R D E R

1. The petitioners challenge the judgment and order dated 20.08.2025 passed by the High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan at Jodhpur in D.B.Special Appeal Writ No. 768 of 2024 titled "*State of Rajasthan & Ors. vs. Mata Prasad Sharma*".
2. Delay condoned.
3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners, we are of the considered view that it would be only in the fitness of circumstances as also the interest of justice, that the petitioners seek review of the impugned order in view of the observations made by the High Court.

4. Liberty is granted to seek appropriate remedies in accordance with law including filing petition seeking review of the impugned order.

5. Should the same be done within a period of four weeks, the question of limitation shall not arise in the course of adjudication of the matter in accordance with law.

6. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach this Court, should the need so arise subsequently.

7. The special leave petition is disposed of with the above liberty.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
