ORDER

The special leave petition has been filed against the judgment and order of the Madurai Bench of Madras High Court dismissing the Criminal Revision Case No. 47 of 2006 and confirming the petitioner's conviction under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act. An application under Section 147 of the Act has been filed for leave to compound the offence. The respondent has filed an affidavit in support of the said application and learned counsel appearing for the respondent submits that the respondent has no objection if the offence is allowed to be compounded.
