Heard Mr. Sanjay R. Hegde, learned counsel for the appellants and Mr. G.V. Chandrashika, learned counsel for the respondent.

The matter pertains to regularisation of the service of the respondent. According to the respondent, she had put in more than 14 years service, much more than qualifying service required to seek regularisation. The High Court of Karnataka has laid down that daily wagers who are appointed subsequent to 1.7.1984, who have put in more than 10 years of qualifying service, are entitled for regularisation and that no exception could be taken.

At the time of hearing, our attention was drawn to the order dated 10.3.2003 (translated copy at Annexure 'R5' at pages 45-47 of the paper book) of the Deputy Commissioner, Hassan. We have perused the same. By the said order, the respondent Smt. S.T. Vimla, typist, has been regularised with effect from the date 5.12.1996 (shown against her name) subject to the conditions stated in the said order, which is placed on record and shall form part of this order.

In view of regularisation now ordered from 5.12.1996, nothing further survives in this appeal to be adjudicated upon any further. The Civil Appeal stands disposed of accordingly. No costs.
