UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The petitioner challenges the impugned judgment and order dated 09.02.2026 in Criminal Revision No.10 of 2026, titled "*Karan Nagar Vs. State of U.P. and Anr.*", passed by the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad.

2. We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

3. We are not inclined to issue notice on merits. As such, the present petition warrants for dismissal. However, only for the purpose of exploring the possibility of settlement, issue notice.

4. Ms. Ruchira Goel, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.1/the State of Uttar Pradesh and Mr. Ujjwal Singh, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.2. Hence, the formal service of notice on the said respondents is waived.

5. Having heard learned counsel on both sides, the submissions would reveal the desire of the parties to explore the possibility of a mediated settlement.

6. In such circumstances, the parties are directed to appear before the Coordinator, Supreme Court Mediation Center on 26.05.2026 at 11.00 a.m. The Coordinator shall appoint a Mediator to enable the parties to make an effort to settle the matter amicably.

7. Initially, the parties are permitted to appear virtually and thereafter, the parties shall appear as per the directions of the Mediator.

8. All expenses towards travel and lodging of the respondent no.2-wife shall be borne by the petitioner-husband.

9. List the matter along with Mediation Report on 07.08.2026.
