O R D E R

1. Heard Mr. Siddharth Aggarwal, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr. Sidharth Khatana, learned counsel for the respondent-State, on advance notice.

2. Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, a lady, was a Sarpanch between 2010 and 2015 and an FIR has been filed on 22nd July, 2025. The petitioner is also 60 years old.

3. Considering the overall facts and circumstances, we set aside the impugned order. We direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be enlarged on anticipatory bail in connection with FIR No.177 of 2025 dated 22nd July, 2025 registered at Police Station Sadar Narnaul, District Mahendergarh, Haryana for offences under Sections 409 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (corresponding to Sections 316 and 318(4) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023).

4. The Special Leave Petition is disposed of in the above terms.

5. Needless to add that the petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation.

6. Pending applications shall also stand disposed of.
