O R D E R

We find no ground to interfere as the SLP against the main order has already been dismissed by this Court by order dated 13.11.2009 in SLP(C)No.28111/2009, 28918/2009 and 29309/2009 and these SLPs have been filed against the rejection of the review petitions.

Learned counsel for the petitioner

apprehends that the petitioner may be non-
suited if he approaches the Tribunal
constituted under the M.P. Madhyastham
Adhikaran Adhinyam, 1983 in view of the
decision in C.A. No.3746 of 2005 dated
14.1.2010.

We find that such an apprehension is without any basis as the High Court in its order dated 29.7.2009 has expressly reserved liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedy before the Arbitration Tribunal constituted under the State Act. As the said

order attained finality, any subsequent order of this Court will have no affect as far as the petitioner is concerned.

The Special Leave Petitions are dismissed accordingly.
