The special leave petition is dismissed.

With a view to ensure that the respondents get the amount due to them in accordance with order dated 4.3.2003 passed by the Reference Court, we deem it proper to issue the following directions:

- i) Within a period of eight weeks from today, the petitioner shall deposit the entire amount payable to respondent nos.1 to 3 with the Special Land Acquisition Officer (Housing), Kanpur.
- ii) Within two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, the Special Land Acquisition

Officer shall depute an officer not below the rank of Naib Tehsildar to contact respondent nos.1 to 3 and inform them about their right to get compensation in terms of order dated 4.3.2003.

The concerned Officer shall ask them to open Bank account, if they already do not have such account.

- iii) Thereafter, the Special Land Acquisition Officer shall ensure that the amount paid by the petitioner is deposited in the Bank account of respondents nos.1 to 3 in the form of account payee cheque(s).

A copy of this order be sent to the Special Land Acquisition Officer (Housing), Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh.
