ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

It has been stated that complaint was dismissed by the District Forum on the ground that the same was not maintainable. Against the said order when the matter was taken in appeal before the State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, the same was allowed, order passed by the District Forum set aside and the matter remanded to it for deciding the complaint on merits. Against the said order when a revision application was filed, the National Consumer Disputes Redressal

Commission [for short, 'the National Commission'] dismissed the complaint but it appears that, under some confusion, observed that Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Limited is directed to reimburse the amount to the complainants though on merits, none of the authorities decided the matter. Accordingly, the order of National Commission is clarified that the complaint shall be decided by the District Forum in accordance with law.

The special leave petitions are, accordingly, disposed of.
