O R D E R

1. Issue notice, returnable in four weeks.
2. In addition to the usual mode, liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve notice through the Standing Counsel for the respondent-Union of India.
3. By way of *ad interim* order, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on bail in connection with R.C. No. 02/2026 for the offence(s) registered under Sections 120(B) read with Sections 420/468/471 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 7 of the P.C. Act (as amended in 2018), pending in the Court of learned Special Judge CBI, Ranchi,

subject to him executing personal bonds for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only), with one or more sureties in the like amount.

4. However, the petitioner is directed to cooperate with the investigation and report to the Investigating Officer as and when directed to do so.
