Delay condoned.

This Contempt Petition is filed by the petitioners praying for drawing up of contempt proceedings against the respondents for alleged violation of the order dated 7.2.2005 passed by this Court. By the aforesaid order, this Court set aside the order of the High Court and remitted the matter to the High Court for a fresh consideration in accordance with law after hearing the parties and thereby disposed of the appeal itself. Order was also passed directing that status quo should be maintained by the parties until further orders by the High Court.

It is alleged that no further or other order was passed varying the status quo order passed by this court.

It is alleged that while the matter was pending before the High Court i.e. on 5.10.2008, the respondents disturbed peaceful physical possession. In that view of the matter, the petitioners have also filed a writ petition before the High Court, which is pending consideration. In view of the fact that this matter was disposed of by this Court on 7.2.2005, directing for maintenance of status quo until further orders by the High Court and since the alleged dispossession has taken place on 5.10.2008 while matter was pending in the High Court, we request the High Court to deal with the matter, relating to alleged violation, if such prayer is made, expeditiously.

The Contempt Petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid observations.
