Leave granted.

This appeal is directed against the interim order dated 2nd August, 2010, passed by the Jodhpur Bench of Rajasthan High Court, in Civil Writ Petition No.6701 of 2010, entertaining the writ petition and passing certain interim orders thereupon.

At the very initial stage a question has been raised as to the maintainability of the writ petition on the allegation that the Badminton Association of India is a private body against which no writ lies.

The said question does not appear to have been considered at all by the High Court while passing the impugned order.

Accordingly, having heard learned counsel for the parties, we set aside the interim order and direct the High Court to consider the question of

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maintainability of the writ petition along with the writ application, on 14th September, 2010, when the matter is said to be listed for final disposal.

The appeal is disposed of accordingly.
