UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The petitioner has been denied anticipatory bail by the High Court in connection with the First Information Report bearing No.24 of 2026 registered with Jalandhar Police Station, Division No.8, for the offence punishable under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 351(1), 351(3), 191(3) and 190 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, respectively (for short, "the BNS, 2023).

2. We take notice of the fact that four persons have been named as accused in the FIR. Three have been granted anticipatory bail by the Sessions Court on the premise that they had caused simple injuries. Insofar as the present petitioner is concerned, the High Court

declined to grant anticipatory bail on the ground that he is responsible for causing grievous injuries. Whether the injuries suffered by the victim would fall within the ambit of "grievous hurt" or not will be looked into by the Trial Court after the medical enters the box.

3. In the facts and circumstances of this case, we are persuaded to exercise our discretion in favour of the petitioner insofar as his plea for grant of anticipatory bail is concerned.

4. In the event of arrest of the petitioner in connection with the First Information Report, referred to above, he shall be released on bail subject to terms and conditions that the Investigating Officer (I.O.) may deem fit to impose. The petitioner shall appear before the I.O. for the purpose of his interrogation.

5. Once the petitioner is released by the I.O., he shall, thereafter, furnish fresh bail bonds to the Trial Court.

6. With the aforesaid, the Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.

7. Pending application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
