Learned counsel for the appearing for the State of West Bengal vehemently opposes the request for bail.

Heard and considered the submissions advanced by the learned counsel for the parties. Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner is in custody for more than two years and six months and the trial has not proceeded for long and recovery from the petitioner is only of 14.5 kg ganja which is less than the commercial quantity, we are of the view that the

petitioner would be entitled to bail.

In view of the above, we direct that the petitioner be released on bail in connection with the F.I.R./Complaint Case No. 159/2023 dated 20.10.2023 registered at Police Station Muchipara, Calcutta, West Bengal, subject to such terms and conditions as may be determined by the Trial Court.

The special leave petition and pending application(s) are disposed of accordingly.
