O R D E R

1. It is not in dispute that some of the petitioners' co-accused have been granted bail by this Court vide orders dated 01.12.2025, 16.02.2026, and 15.05.2026 passed in SLP (Crl.) Nos. 16447/2025, 17655/2026, 1839/2026, 4299/2026, etc.
2. For the reasons assigned in those orders and without expressing any opinion on the merits, the prayer for bail is allowed. The petitioners are directed to be released on bail on the same terms and conditions. The petitioners shall regularly appear before the Trial Court, and in case they are found to be absent, it shall be taken as a misuse of the concession of bail.
3. The Special Leave Petitions are, accordingly, disposed of. Pending applications, if any, also stand closed.
